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Action Item 90.2 Update:

Significant discussion was had around the intent of this action item. The original intent was to provide an understanding as to the role culvert relining has in the context of capital work/improvement of an asset. The capital work outcome is to provide improvement in the asset performance. It was determined that culvert relining was considered an equal and alternative technical solution to the commonly accepted alternatives (Polypropylene corrugated pipe (Blackmax)/Concrete pipes/culverts etc.) and as such is not required to be delineated separately.

Action Item 95.1(a) Update:

Due to the need for councils to further consider their requirements, constraints and opportunities in latter years, it was determined that discussions at this meeting focus on consensus for the 17/18 works program, with the 18/19 to 20/21 to be considered at a meeting held on 18th April 2018 (IPWEA Conference).

Pre meeting Background:

(8/3/2018) : RRTG TC Flying Minute for the amendment of the 17/18 works program sent and supported by majority:

"In response to the request for projects to cover the \$1,013,601 funding shortfall in our current TIDS budget, we have received a number of requests and propose the following recommendation:

Discussion was raised around the additional reporting and forecasting recently introduced by TMR Far Northern District. The District now requires 3 returns per month (Expenditure, Accrual and Forecasting) where the Road and Transport Alliance only requires one form to be completed. TMR district personnel identified that this is now TMR Far Northern standard protocol. After some discussion between TMR personnel and present member councils, it was requested that a note to the board be made requesting TMR Far North review the current level reporting and forecasting currently required and combine into one return as per previous reporting requirements.
