## 6. New Business

99.1	<b>Consideration of 17/18 TIDS Works Program Expenditure</b>	ALL COUNCILS
<p>The 17/18 TIDS works program under expenditure was presented, with the reasons detailed as to why the under expenditure occurred. It was identified by TMR that there are ATSI TIDS programs providing better performance statistics (referring to overall expenditure % and earlier delivery timing through the financial year. It was noted that these programs are 100% funded through ATSI TIDS, with the LG TIDS program 50% funded by LG funds, this providing severe limitation to councils ability to adjust their capital works(set a year in advance) to bring forward projects and cover funding shortfalls.</p> <p>TMR noted that their records reflected a final underspend of \$292,663. This represents a total expenditure of approximately 95%.</p> <p>In light of the above, the group then considered opportunities to minimise the prospect of under-expenditure in future:</p>

<p>During the RRTG meeting of the 18 June 2018, the RRTG recognised the possibility of under expenditure, and therein requested the following of the RRTG – TC:</p> <p>Minute 166 (RRTG meeting of the 18 June 2018):</p> <p><i>‘The RRTG Technical Committee consider the under expenditure and programing of the TIDS works program and make recommendations for consideration at the next FNQ RRTG meeting on 13 August 2018.’</i></p>		

Following on from the above the group discussed various ways of minimising programme risk, with the following outcomes being recommended:

- (a) All RRTG member councils are to (as far as practical) adjust their internal capital works programs to bring TIDS projects forward into the first two quarters of the financial year(July-December)
- (b) At the end of December, council CEO's will be contacted to obtain formal confirmation of the project estimate and that council has the capacity and ability to deliver outstanding projects.
- (c) Those councils with projects over two financial years will be requested to bring forward any available expenditure to the first year
- (d) The RRTG TC are to nominate by December, any projects with a cost estimate overrun so they can be 're prioritised' for potential funding availability.

It was further noted that due to consistent lack of representation from some councils, the RRTG TC is now considering the requirement of attendance to meetings as a prerequisite to councils receiving TIDS funding. It is acknowledged that there is often significant travel time associated with this; however call in facilities are available.

**17-18 TIDS Program**

- State-wide actual RTA TIDS spend was 99.58%.
- The Board has raised concerns with the amount of delivery and expenditure being incurred in the last 4-6 weeks of 2017-18, and the effort required by all involved in meeting the Government's expectations of 100% acquittal.
- SCDF was 89% allocated and expended in 2017-18, mainly due to state-wide initiatives (e.g. AusRAP and HV Assessment Guidelines).

**2018-19 TIDS Program**

- **SCDF Funding** - \$484,669 still available – RRTGs are strongly encouraged to actively consider capability gaps and opportunities which could be used to develop staff capability.
- **RRTG ATSI TIDS** – Participating ASCs and RRTG members are reminded to refer to the Transitional Guidelines, and to increase engagement, to build understanding of acceptable program management practices and ensure current funding allocations can be maintained and/or increased.
