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## **BUSINESS ARISING OUT OF MINUTES**

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**Minute 178 & 169 – Department of Transport and Main Roads to work with Etheridge Shire Council with recommendations moving forward regarding give-way signs on narrow bridges on the road between Georgetown and Mount Surprise.**

Mr Hodgman advised initial assessments and sought advice from road experts in Brisbane. Looking at appropriate treatment and in the process of drafting designs and seeking approval.

Mr Hodgman advised on behalf of Ms Lencz that the program is now being led by TMRs Road Safety Programs team, who are developing the guidelines and business rules for the program. Currently with the Minister and anticipated release in the New Year for sharing with the RRTG Group.

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**Minute 197 – DTMR looking at improved signage in relation to the Bruce Highway (section South of Mourilyn & Tully) and Canecutter Way.**

Mr Hodgman advised working closely with CCRC regarding the signage throughout the area, looking to find suitable sites and working with councils. Looking for appropriate signage re RV and Caravans.

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## 216 Minutes of the Technical Committee Meetings

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Minutes as noted for meetings held 22 February and 24 May, with the unconfirmed minutes of the meeting held 25 July 2019 due for uploading to the FNQROC website by the end of the month.

L Rankine extended appreciation from the RRTG Technical Committee to David Matuschka (TMR) whom went above and beyond to assist with the finalisation of the EOFY expenditure and data from councils. Whilst the FNQ RRTG reported 100% expenditure for the 18/19 financial year, the Technical Committee acknowledged there is an opportunity to improve processes for the coming financial year (19/20), noting the following new processes: -

1. The FNQ RRTG TC will now be enforcing the requirement to have detailed design completed prior to the start of the financial year in which the works are done.
2. Projects scheduled for construction commencement from March to June of the current financial year are to be rolled over to the next financial year; and
3. As per the proposed recommendation put to the RRTG for endorsement today, the Technical Committee will have the delegated authority to reallocate (from savings) up to 10% of a project for cost for overruns provided the project scope is consistent with the project approved by the RRTG.

2. *Up to \$210,000 to Project 227 (TMR #1125061) – Tablelands Regional Council – Toga-Kairi Road – Widen shoulders and sealing (LRRS) – Ranked 133<sup>rd</sup> – (Bring forward of previous allocation of \$210,000 from 2019/2020 to 208/2019)"*

- TIDS State-wide EOFY expenditure was reported as 100%, however some accruals remain unresolved, please ensure any outstanding claims/invoices are submitted and processed immediately.
- Technical Committees are asked to identify any 2019-20 TIDS projects triggering signage early, to ensure signs are prepared and photos (evidence) are taken. Technical Committees should have a copy of the Signage Policy but this can be re-sent if needed.
- Participating Indigenous Councils and RRTG members are reminded to ensure forward programs of eligible works projects are submitted and considered in upcoming RRTG program development activities. RTA TIDS may be allocated to Indigenous Council projects at 100%.

- Key dates for noting: -
  - 18 July: EOFY Expenditure Report
  - 22 July: EOFY Acquittal Forms – **due 16<sup>th</sup> September 2019**
  - 25 July: New SCDF Submission Forms – 1<sup>st</sup> round applications **due 30 January 2020**

- RRTG Assembly @ LGAQ Conference in Cairns (14 October) – Alliance 2018-19 Progress Report will be released and provides a good opportunity to network with the Alliance board members in region.

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## 219 Works Program Update – Mr Lachlan Rankine

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- As previously mentioned and noting the circulated Flying Minutes there is a demonstrated ongoing need for a more proactive approach from Member Councils in relation to the internal adjustment of each councils capital works program, such that the TIDS projects are completed earlier in the year, to allow better inter council management between of any under-expenditure at EOFY, to facilitate and ensure 100% EOFY spend.
- The next Works Program will be tabled at the October RRTG meeting for adoption.

**ACTION:** 4 year works program to be submitted to the FNQRRTG for adoption in October.
