The position will be offered as a fixed-term 18-month secondment across all our member councils mid-January.

We are seeking an exceptional individual for this role which builds on the foundations of the Q CRC Climate Resilient Councils pilot project (Cairns, Yarrabah, Mareeba, Tablelands, FNQROC) and the QRA Regional Resilience Strategies. In addition to continuing the implementation of those plans, the FNQROC Climate Resilience Coordinator will work in partnership with The Cairns Institute (James Cook University), Gulf Savanna NRM and Terrain NRM to explore and focus on innovative and diverse pathways to build climate and drought resilience across FNQROC councils, communities, and industries.
