As part of the rollout of the [Tropical North Queensland Regional Mountain Bike Strategy](#), FNQROC are establishing a working group to review or design single and multi-day adventure cycling and bikepacking routes and journeys across the region. The working group will explore the opportunity to grow participation in adventure cycling and how the region can position itself as a premier destination for immersive, sustainable, and culturally respectful off road cycling experiences and routes. What's involved? ...

FNQROC will engage the working group over a period of around 12 months beginning in March 2026. The working group will meet for two single-day workshops (in person) and then every two months or so for 1-2 hours (online or in person) over the course of 2026... We appreciate your time is valuable and that life happens so we will endeavour to be as flexible as we can.

Workshops: The first workshop is scheduled for **March 11** in Cairns, the second will be scheduled in consultation with the working group (the workshops will be in person and held during business hours).

Meetings: There will be around four online (or in person) meetings to discuss and review the outcomes of the workshops and make recommendations for next steps. Please consider if you can attend these meetings? ... would you prefer them to take place during business hours or after hours?
